Wood Framing and Targeted Strengthening

A contract was awarded to Wiss, Janney, Elstner (WJE) Associates, Inc. to prepare an engineering plan and construction documents for the Wood Framing and Targeted Strengthening project. The plan and the construction documents will be used by the Parish to obtain bids from contractors to complete this project. The contract has five tasks and each task requires the approval of the Parish before the next task can be started. WJE is currently working on the first two tasks approved by Fr. Laible at the recommendation of the Finance Council.

<u>Phase II, Approved Project(s) Awaiting Contract and Insurance Documents</u>: The financial resources are in place, the Finance Council has approved the hiring of a contractor and the Pastor has approved the project. The Contractor has been contacted and the Parish is awaiting the contractor's Formal Contract and Insurance Papers.

<u>Phase III, Contract(s) forwarded to the Diocese</u>: The contractor's Formal Contract and their Insurance Papers have been forwarded with a Formal Request for Resolution to the Diocese for Final Legal and Insurance Reviews.

<u>Phase IV, Contract(s) has been Awarded</u>: The Parish has received final approval to sign the Formal Contract from the Diocese. The Pastor has signed the contract and the contractor has been notified.

<u>Phase V. Restoration/Repair/Construction</u>: The contractor has provided an approximate start date to the Parish for the restoration/repair/construction work.
