(Note 3). Campaign Expenses consist primarily of credit card processing fees.

- † Tuck-pointing of the Church began on June 29th and will take a minimum of 8 weeks to complete. Barricades will be placed at the front entrance of the Church Monday – Friday during the tuckpointing of the Logan Street side of the Church. During this time the side door will be used to enter the Church for daily Mass.
- 15 Holy Family Parishioners recently toured the Jacksonville Art Glass Studio to observe the restoration process of Holy Family's stained glass windows. To give everyone an idea about what the restoration process for the windows looks like, we will publish pictures that were taken during the tour and an article by one of our parishioners in a future bulletin. One more tour will take place the week of July 25, 2016.
- † On Thursday, June 30, 2016 Jacksonville Art Glass removed additional windows that will go through the restoration process beginning in July.
- Jacksonville Art Glass is tentatively scheduled to begin installing windows that have been fully † restored during the week of July 11, 2016.

Phase II, Approved Project(s) Awaiting Contract and Insurance Documents: The financial resources are in place, the Finance Council has approved the hiring of a contractor and the Pastor has approved the project. The Contractor has been contacted and the Parish is awaiting the contractor's Formal Contract and Insurance Papers.

<u>Phase III, Contract(s) forwarded to the Diocese</u>: The contractor's Formal Contract and their Insurance Papers have been forwarded with a Formal Request for Resolution to the Diocese for Final Legal and Insurance Reviews.

<u>Phase IV, Contract(s) has been Awarded</u>: The Parish has received final approval to sign the Formal Contract from the Diocese. The Pastor has signed the contract and the contractor has been notified.

<u>Phase V. Restoration/Repair/Construction</u>: The contractor has provided an approximate start date to the Parish for the restoration/repair/construction work.
