Be safe during the summer months.



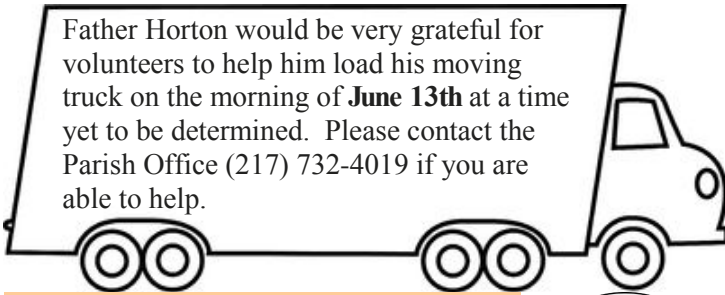
### Farewell to Father Horton

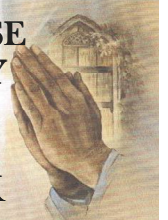
