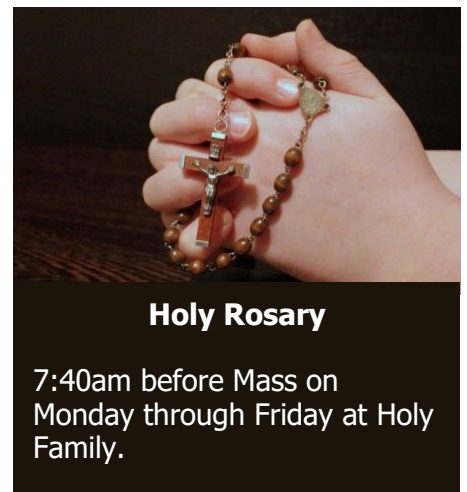
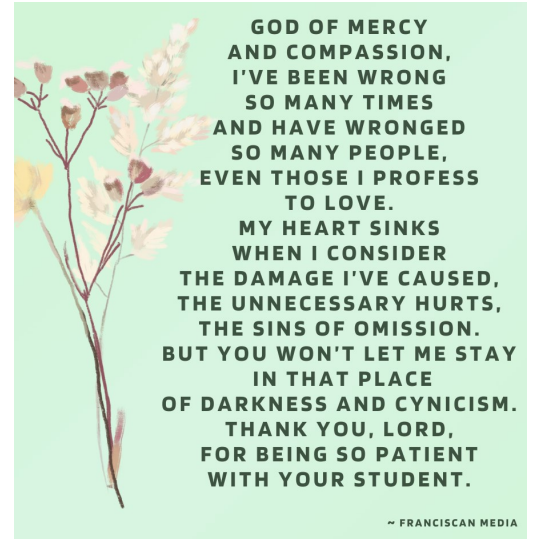

A LOT OF GRATITUDE

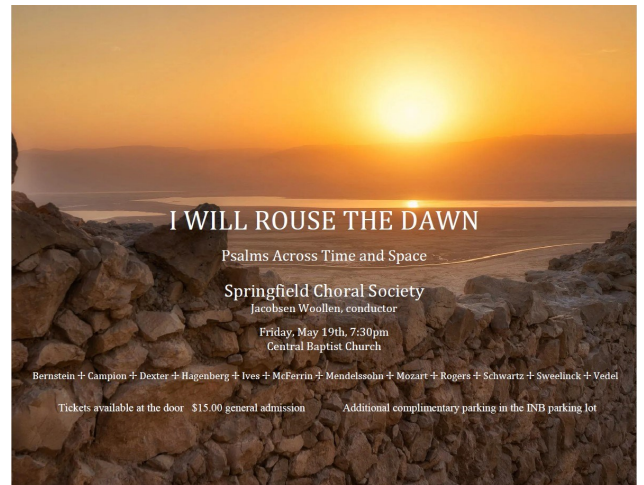
