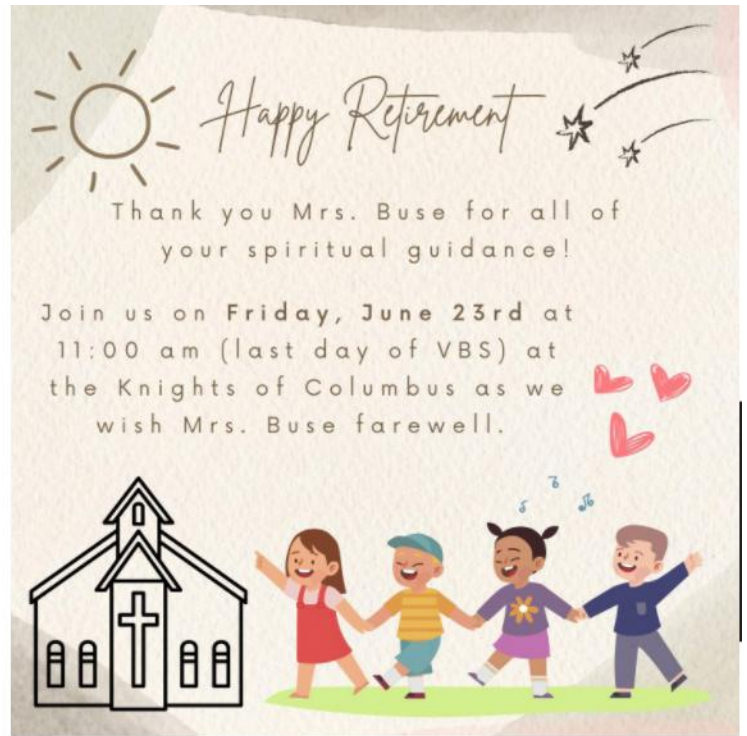

Growing Disciples

In August 2022, Bishop Tylka announced the *Growing Disciples* 2-year pastoral planning process for our Diocese. "Among the challenges expected to be addressed in the next two years are a changing regional and diocesan landscape, national trends regarding religion, and too few priests to adequately staff more than 150 parishes.... The pastoral planning process will incorporate the "five foundations" outlined by Bishop Tylka in his message for Easter 2022 — evangelization, the Eucharist, discipleship, vocations, and the legacy of Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen.... The new pastoral planning process will build upon what was learned from the "Growing in Faith Together" diocese-wide initiative a decade ago. It will be more comprehensive in scope and implementation.... Initial proposals for parish and school configurations are to be made and reviewed in 2023, with a pastoral plan finalized by Pentecost 2024. Implementation of new structures would take place in the following two years."
