Who is St. Anthony?

He is formally known as St. Anthony of Padua, also as St. Anthony of Lisbon. He is one of 36 Doctors of the Church and the first theology teacher in the Franciscan order. Many cities claim a connection to him as he lived in Lisbon, Coimbra, Morocco, Messina, Montepaolo, Bologna, LaVerna, and then in Padua. He died at age 36 in a convent in Arcella outside Padua on June 13, his feast day. He is credited with performing many miracles during his lifetime, including healing the sick and injured. A fun fact: he is the patron saint of lost items.

Why Pray to St. Anthony to Find Something Lost?

St. Anthony had a book of psalms he used to write his sermons, it contained all his notes and comments. One day, a discontented novice quit the order and took St. Anthony's book as he left. St. Anthony was so upset that he prayed that the thief return along with the book. The young man returned to the order and his studies bringing St. Anthony's precious book of thoughts. This book is said to be preserved in the Franciscan friary in Bologna.

Now, when you lose your keys, your wallet, your eyeglasses, your cell phone, or, perhaps, a momentary loss of thoughts, you can pray to St. Anthony: "O Dear St. Anthony, come around. My (lost thing) is lost and cannot be found."
