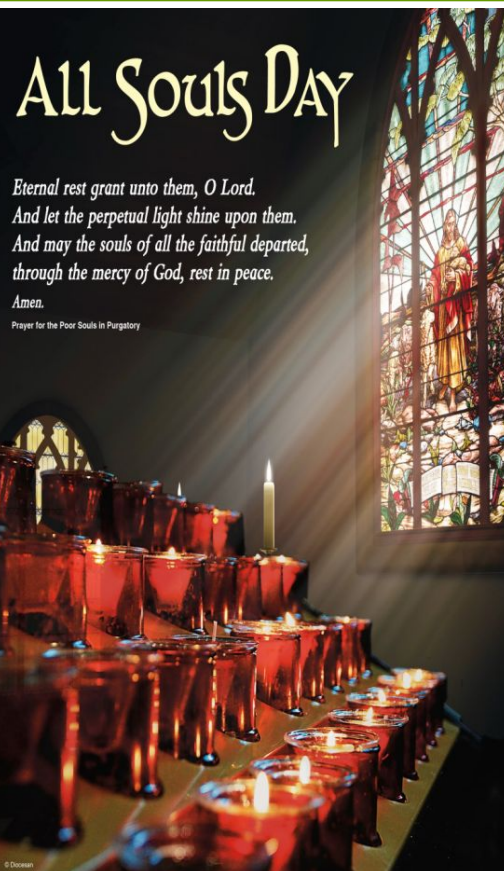

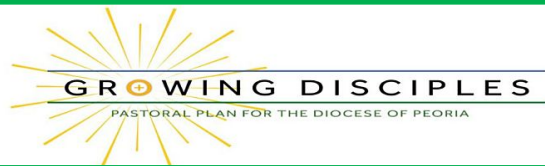

Saint Memorials This Week

(Adapted from My Catholic Life!)

Solemnity of All Saints (11/1) - Today is a Holy Day of Obligation.

The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls) (11/2) - Rooted in ancient Christian tradition, St. Odilo of Cluny established a memorial of all the faithful departed in 988. It was accepted in Rome in the 13th Century.

St. Martin de Porres, Religious (11/3) - He was born in Lima, Peru in 1639. He was a lay brother who ministered to the poor and the sick, especially African slaves. He was devoted to the Holy Eucharist, and was a close friend of St. Rose of Lima. He is the Patron Saint of social justice and peoples of mixed races as his father was Spanish and his mother an African slave.

Memorial of Saint Charles Borromeo, Bishop (11/4) - Patron Saint of apple orchards, bishops, catechism writers, catechists, catechumens, seminarians, starchmakers, and spiritual directors. Invoked against abdominal pain, colic, stomach diseases, and ulcers. He was canonized by Pope Paul V on November 1, 1610. Today's Saint was a cardinal, archbishop, and papal legate. He played a role in the final session of the Council of Trent and supported clerical codes of conduct and seminary reform while setting an example of clerical simplicity and charity in his own life.

The Holy Father's Intention for the Month of November 2023:

For the Pope

We pray for the Holy Father; as he fulfills his mission, may he continue to accompany the flock entrusted to him, with the help of the Holy Spirit.

November is the Month for Souls in Purgatory.

During November, we are called to remember "our brothers & sisters who have fallen asleep in the hope of the resurrection." (*Eucharistic Prayer II*). The **Book of All Souls** is located to your right as you enter the Nave. Here, you may write the names of your beloved dead who you wish to be remembered in prayer during this month.

Lastly, consider saying a Novena to St. Elizabeth of Hungary from 11/8-11/17. Her Feast Day is 11/17. She is the Patron Saint of Third Order Franciscans, bakers, beggars, brides, charitable societies and workers, exiles, falsely accused people, homeless people, hospitals, lacemakers, nursing homes, nursing services, people ridiculed for their piety, and widows. Invoked against in-law problems, the death of children, and toothaches.

What is the difference between a Catechumen and a Candidate?

A catechumen is a person preparing for baptism. Anyone asking for baptism becomes a catechumen, even if for only a moment, as with the Baptism of a Child when an anointing with the Oil of Catechumens takes place right before the blessing of the baptismal water. In the RCIA, an adult is made a catechumen at the "Rite of Acceptance into the Catechumenate," which takes place months before baptism at the Easter Vigil. A catechumen is a member of the Christian community but not a baptized one.

A candidate is a baptized member of the Christian community (adult or child) preparing for sacraments (Confirmation and/or Holy Communion). Adults baptized in a Christian tradition other than the Catholic tradition are candidates in the RCIA asking for full communion in the Catholic Church. We have a participant in the RCIA who is preparing to be made a catechumen in December and one who is preparing for full communion in the Catholic Church this spring. They are counting on your prayers for them and the RCIA team.
