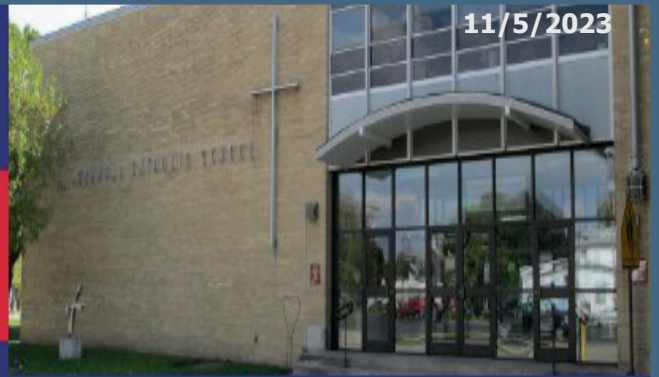
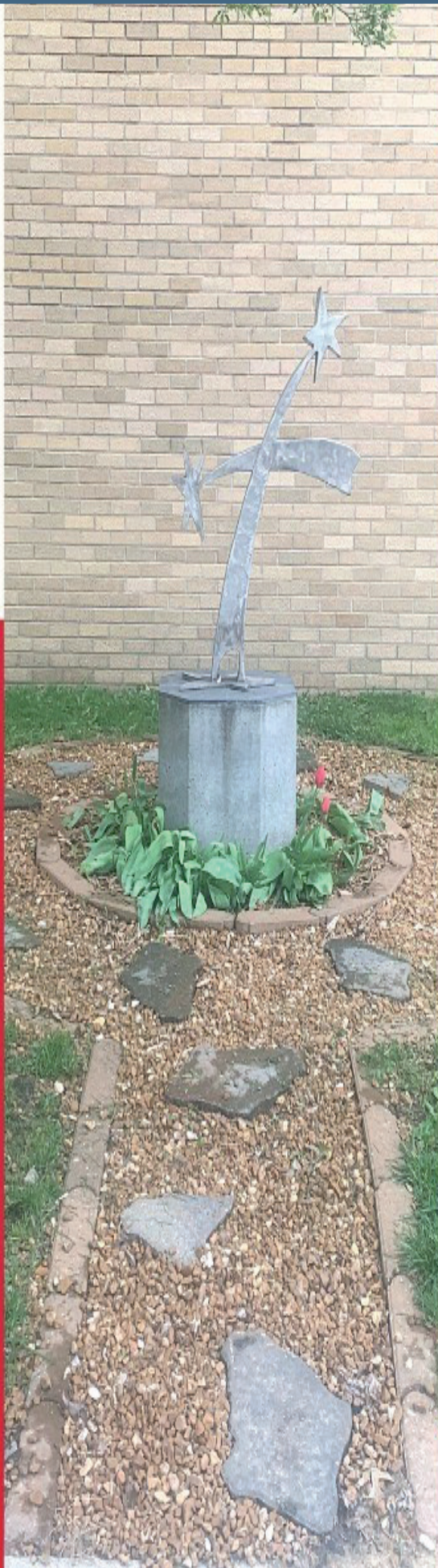

Lastly, consider saying a Novena to St. Elizabeth of Hungary from 11/8-11/17. Her Feast Day is 11/17. She is the Patron Saint of Third Order Franciscans, bakers, beggars, brides, charitable societies and workers, exiles, falsely accused people, homeless people, hospitals, lacemakers, nursing homes, nursing services, people ridiculed for their piety, and widows. Invoked against in-law problems, the death of children, and toothaches.

Saint Memorials This Week (Adapted from My Catholic Life!)

Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome (11/9) - Today's feast commemorates the most important church on earth. In the city of Rome, there are four major basilicas. The first three are Saint Peter's Basilica in Vatican City, the Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls, and the Basilica of Saint Mary Major. The fourth is the Archbasilica Cathedral of the Most Holy Savior and of Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist in the Lateran, also called Saint John Lateran, or the Lateran Basilica for short. Of the four major basilicas, the oldest and most important is Saint John Lateran. Though the pope now lives next to Saint Peter's Basilica, Saint John Lateran is the official cathedral of Rome. That means Saint John Lateran is not only the mother church of the Archdiocese of Rome, but also the mother church of the entire world. Though the basilica was first dedicated to Christ the Savior, in the tenth century Pope Sergius III added a new baptistry and rededicated the basilica to Saint John the Baptist. In the twelfth century, Pope Lucius II dedicated the basilica to Saint John the Evangelist. The basilica, therefore, honors Christ the Savior first, and the two Saint Johns as co-patrons.

Memorial of Saint Leo the Great, Pope and Doctor of the Church (11/10) - Declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Benedict XIV in 1754. Pope Leo acted to protect the physical welfare of Rome. In 451, barbarians from the north arrived in northern Italy with the intention of conquering the Western Roman Empire. Before the invaders advanced to Rome, Pope Leo went out to meet them to broker peace. When he met up with their leader, Attila the Hun, legend has it that Saints Peter and Paul appeared behind the pope with swords and in a threatening position. Attila was overwhelmed by the sight. He and his army withdrew in fear for their lives. Pope Leo's final years in Rome were spent preaching and teaching. He left behind about 100 sermons and 150 letters, all of which present many clear teachings on Christ and the Church in a pastoral and convincing way. Pope Leo also fostered personal devotions, fasting, and almsgiving. He enlivened the liturgy, helped the sick, built churches, and preached the Gospel to his people.

Memorial of Saint Martin of Tours, Bishop (11/11) - Patron Saint of beggars, cavalry, equestrians, geese, horses, innkeepers, Pontifical Swiss Guards, quartermasters, reformed alcoholics, soldiers, tailors, and winemakers. Invoked against alcoholism and poverty. St. Martin was a Roman soldier who converted after he had a vision of Christ wearing the cloak Martin had given to a freezing beggar. After his conversion, he rejected violence and left the army for the life of an eremitic monk. From there, he began preaching throughout the region and performing many miracles. Eventually, he was elected bishop of Tours, though he rejected the office when first offered.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS PROCESS (RCIA) - COME JOIN US



RCIA: Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens

The first liturgical rite in the RCIA is the "Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens." Before celebrating the rite, it is important that the inquirer experience an initial conversion and express a sincere desire to repent, pray, and be open to the Holy Spirit as a guide and advocate. This rite is a public way for a catechumen (the person preparing for baptism) to declare his intention to be baptized and for the church, the Logan County Catholic Community, to accept him as one God has called to become a member of the community. God is the one who calls people to baptism and the community cooperates with God's call by supporting the conversion journey with prayer.

Please continue your prayer for all involved in the RCIA process. We will celebrate "Rite of Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens" at Holy Family Church on Sunday, December 10 at the 10 a.m. Mass.
