## Saint Memorials This Week (Adapted from My Catholic Life!)

**Feast of Christ the King of the Universe (11/26)** - On this final Sunday of the liturgical year, the liturgy celebrates Jesus as Lord of Love, revealing God's love for all people and calling his followers to live in that love. Our liturgical year is ordered in such a way as to lead us through the entire mystery of salvation won for us in Christ.

Each liturgical year begins with Advent, when we ponder the Incarnation that leads us to the celebration of Jesus' birth at Christmas. Following Christmas we enter into the public ministry of Christ during Ordinary Time, which begins with the feast of His Baptism. In the midst of Ordinary Time, we enter the deepest paschal mystery of Lent and Easter, culminating with the Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday. The Easter Season concludes with Christ's Ascension and Pentecost, the beginning of the Church. Finally, after the rest of Ordinary Time, we come to the great Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, commonly referred to as the Feast of Christ the King.

The liturgical feast of Christ the King was added to the Church calendar in 1925, when Pope Pius XI instituted it. The world was in political and social chaos. After World War I ended in 1918, secularism began to grow worldwide, and communist and fascist ideologies emerged, leading many to question and even abandon their faith. Pope Pius XI felt that he needed to remind the Church and the world that there is only one King, and that King is not only the King of Catholics, He is the King of humanity, of the entire Universe.

**Feast of Saint Andrew, Apostle (11/30)** - Patron Saint of boatmen, butchers, farm workers, fish dealers, fishermen, happy marriages, miners, paralytics, pregnant women, ropemakers, sailmakers, sailors, singers, spinsters, textile workers, water carriers, and women who wish to become mothers. Invoked against cramps, convulsions, dysentery, fever, gout, neck pain, paralysis, sore throats, and whooping cough. Andrew was a disciple of John the Baptist. Andrew was the first to follow Jesus and brought his brother Simon Peter, to Jesus. Andrew is, therefore, the first of the Apostles to be called and to respond to that call. For that reason, the Greek Church calls Andrew the "Protokletos," meaning, "the first called." Peter founded the Church of Rome in the West, and his brother founded the Church in the East, revealing the unity of East and West.

**First Sunday of Advent (12/3)** - Advent begins with a call to vigilance ("Be vigilant at all times and pray." Luke 21:36a). There are numerous Scripture passages that call us to this vigilance and anticipation of the Lord's coming. Being vigilant means that we are prepared. We often are not prepared to celebrate the birth of Christ within our hearts. The first week of Advent also offers the focus of the Second Coming of Christ - Jesus will return again, in all splendor and glory, to judge the living and the dead. We profess that fact every Sunday in our Creed. Advent is a time to prepare for the celebration of the first coming of Jesus in the flesh, but it is also a time to acknowledge that His first coming is ultimately fulfilled in His final glorious coming.

As Advent begins, reflect upon how ready you are for Jesus' coming. Are you preparing for it with the same fervor that you prepare for Christmas through shopping, cooking, decorating, etc.? Are you looking forward to that day when He will return? Are you preparing for the spiritual celebration of His birth? Are you awake and attentive to the numerous ways that God speaks to you on a daily basis? If you find that you are not as prepared for His return in glory as you'd like to be, make this Advent a time when you get your heart ready. Commit to prayer, spiritual exercises, reflection, and attentiveness to His gentle and glorious voice.

**Lord, as Advent begins, help me to put my eyes on You. Help me to open my ears to Your voice. And, help me to open my heart to Your glorious presence. May I be attentive to You in every way You desire to come to me. Jesus, I trust in You.**
