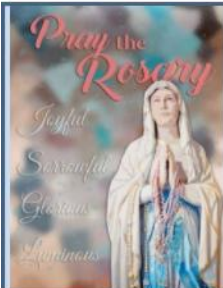

On Friday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> and Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, Elkhart NAG (Needs and Goals) will be hosting their annual plant sale at Village Hall in downtown Elkhart. The sale runs on Friday, 10 am to 6 pm, and 8 am to 12 pm on Saturday.

NAG will offer a variety of bedding and vegetable plants, along with flowering hanging baskets (these go fast). Everyone who buys a plant(s) will be eligible to put their name into a drawing to receive a door prize, which is a hanging basket.

NAG was established, by Mrs. Susan Green in 1984, with the intent of working towards the betterment of Elkhart. 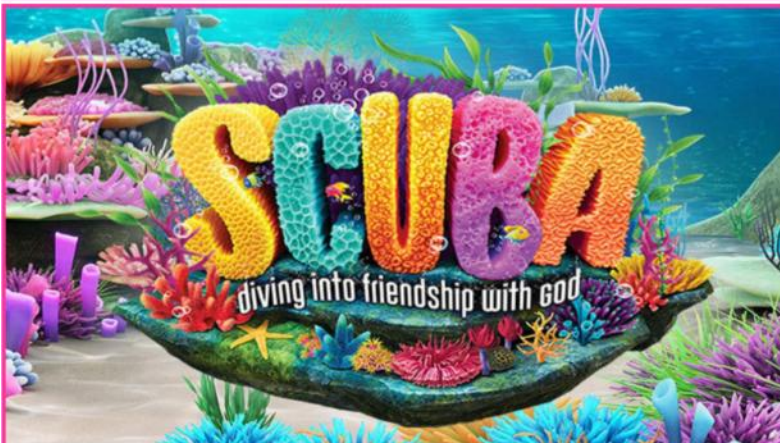

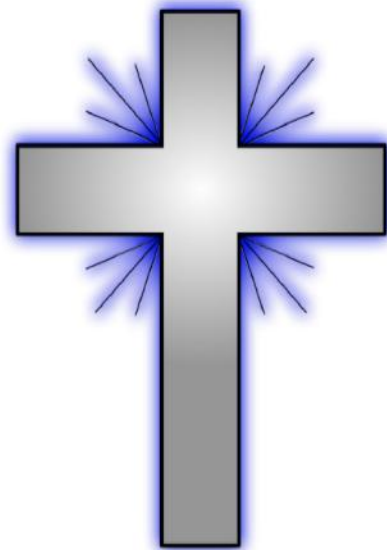
