the Church celebrates the Memorial on September 15.

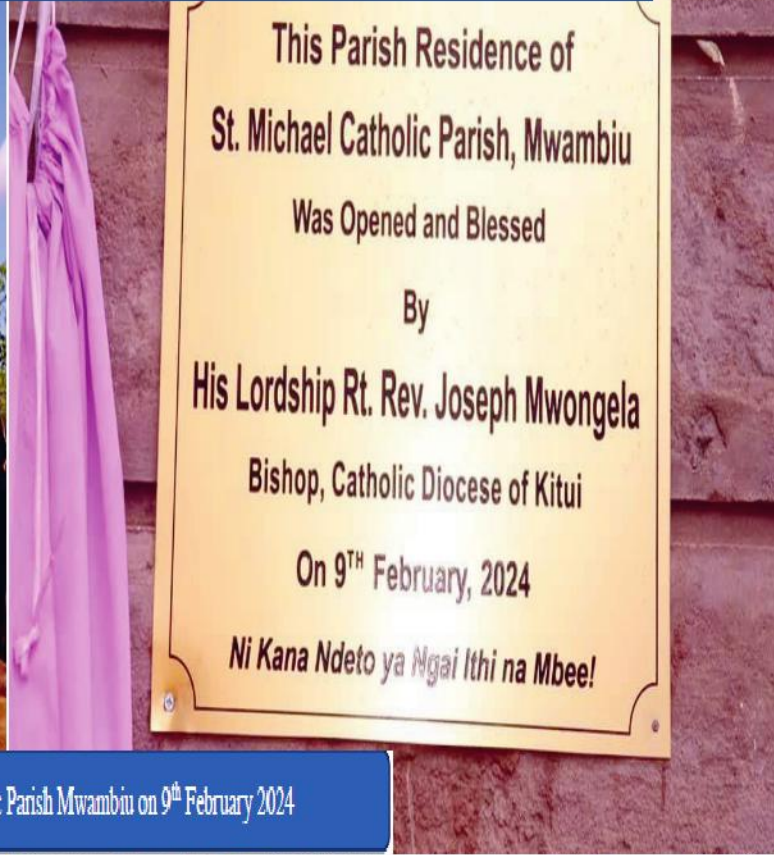
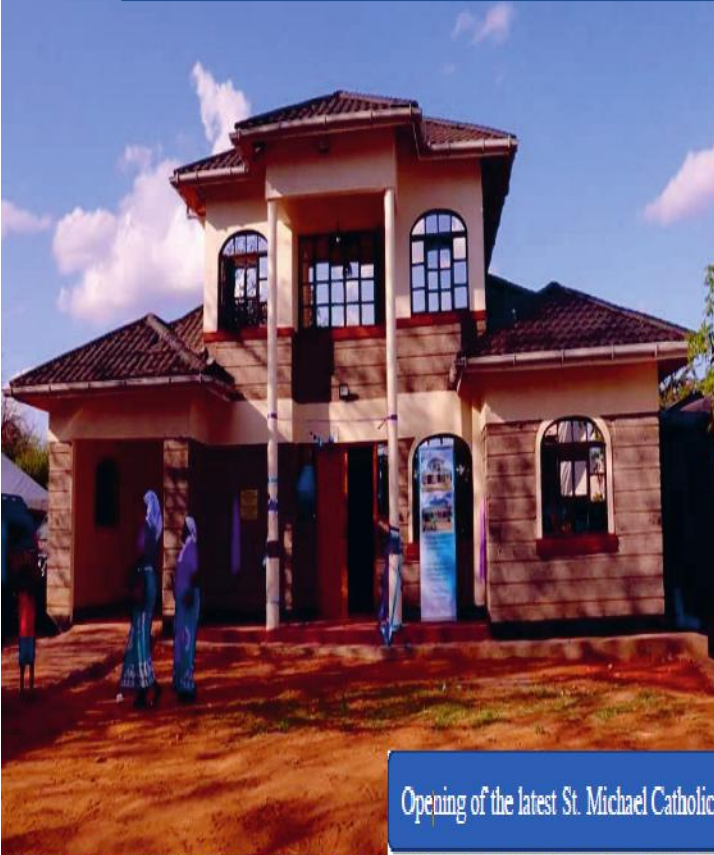
Traditionally, the Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows commemorates the seven sorrows in the Heart of Mary as noted in Scripture:

- 1) The prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:33-35)
- 2) The flight into Egypt (Matthew 2:13-15)
- 3) Loss of the Child Jesus for three days (Luke 2:41-50)
- 4) Mary meets Jesus on His way to Calvary (Luke 23:27-31)
- 5) Crucifixion and Death of Jesus (John 19:25-30)
- 6) The body of Jesus being taken from the Cross (Luke 23:50-54; John 19:31-37)
- 7) The burial of Jesus (Isaiah 53:8-9; Luke 23:50-56)

Sorrow does not mean sadness, here. It is one of the blessed actions in the Beatitudes, and thus one of the holiest qualities we can possess. In this context of the Beatitudes, a heart that mourns is a heart that loves.

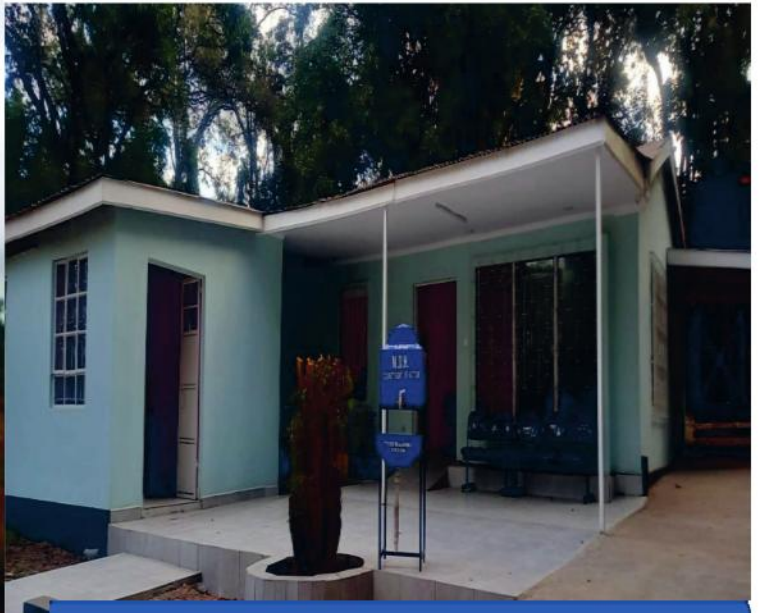
