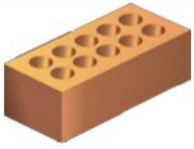

A young successful executive was traveling through a neighborhood street, going a bit too fast in his new car. He was watching for kids darting out from between parked cars and slowed down when he thought he saw something. As his car passed, no children appeared. Instead, a brick smashed into the car's side door! He slammed on the brakes and backed up to spot where it happened.

He hurriedly lifted the boy back into his wheelchair, then took out a handkerchief and cleaned up the boy's fresh scrapes and cuts. The child said "Thank you and may God bless you." Too shook up for words, he watched as the boy pushed his brother up the sidewalk towards home. As he walked to his car, it was clear the damage was very noticeable, but he never bothered to repair the damage. He kept the dent as a reminder of this message: "Don't go through life so fast that someone has to throw a brick at you to get your attention."

In October 2002 St. John Paul II wrote the Apostolic Letter *Rosarium Virginis Mariae* (the Rosary of the Virgin Mary)."

This letter introduced five new mysteries, called the Luminous or Mysteries of Light:

1. Jesus' Baptism in the Jordan
2. Jesus' self manifestation at the wedding of Cana
3. Proclamation of the Kingdom of God, with the call to conversion
4. the Transfiguration, and
5. the Institution of the Eucharist.
