MONTHLY DEDICATION - OCTOBER

The month of October is dedicated to the [Holy Rosary](#). The Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated on October 7.

In October 2002, St. John Paul II wrote the Apostolic Letter *Rosarium Virginis Mariae* (the Rosary of the Virgin Mary)."

This letter introduced five new mysteries, called the Luminous Mysteries or Mysteries of Light highlighting:

1. Jesus' Baptism in the Jordan
2. Jesus' self manifestation at the wedding of Cana
3. Jesus' Proclamation of the Kingdom of God, with the call to conversion
4. the Transfiguration, and
5. the Institution of the Eucharist.

Try to make a concerted effort to pray the Rosary together as a family during the month of October, read the Apostolic Letter to understand the beauty of this devotion more deeply, and pray the Luminous Mysteries.

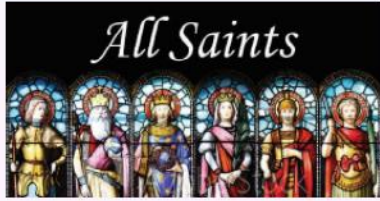
